AT 36.51%, USA leads in terms of the geographical spread of FIIs in value terms, followed by Mauritius (21.21%), Singapore (15.1%), UK (7.24%) and Luxembourg (4.25%)

OF THE 454 FIIs, 33% of them are registered in Mauritius followed by the US (25%), the UK (8%) Luxembourg (6%) and Singapore (5%)
