

Nifty 500 ownership: FPI share falls, DIIs' up

FPIs BOUGHT ABOUT \$4 billion worth of equities in the secondary market in the June quarter. They bought stocks in banks, diversified financials, telecom services and transportation sectors, and

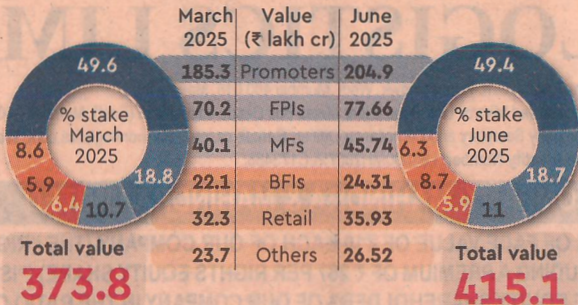
sold electric utilities and IT services. DIIs bought around \$20 billion. While FPI holding (including ADR and GDR) in the Nifty 500 Index fell to 18.7%, DII holding was up marginally at 16.9%, shows a Kotak Institutional Equities report.
