

CSR Spending Rises 23% To Over ₹22K Cr In FY25

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) spend by companies listed on NSE main board rose 23% to ₹22,212 crore in 2024-25 from ₹18,011 crore in 2023-24, according to a report. This increase in spending is seen to be on account of 22% rise in average net profit (of the preceding 3 years) of these companies, 2% of which needs to be spent on CSR activities
