

MFs CLOSE GAP WITH FIIs IN NSE FIRMS' SHAREHOLDING

MUTUAL FUNDS' SHAREHOLDING in NSE-listed companies rose from 11.46% in March 2026 to 11.58% in June, data from Prime Database shows. Foreign institutional investors' (FIIs) shareholding fell from 16.12% to a 14-year low of 15.88% during the same period. So, the gap between FII and mutual fund ownership narrowed to 4.30 percentage points in the June quarter. It nearly halved over the past two years, from 8.75 percentage points as of March 31, 2024. At its peak, the gap stood at 17.14 percentage points on March 31, 2015, when FIIs held 20.70%, compared with just 3.56% by mutual funds.
