

# FII investment: Value at 6-year high, ownership down



While the total value of FII holding in NSE-listed companies hit a 6-year high in the quarter ended March 2015 at ₹19.32 lakh crore, up by 56% from a year ago, FII ownership in percentage terms went down to 6.44% in the quarter from 6.61% one year back, says a report by Prime Database

SINCE MARCH 2010, FII ownership by percentage has seen only a marginal increase, up at **6.44% from 6.38%**

are registered in the US followed by Mauritius (24%), the UK (13%) and Singapore (8%).
